Zoltan is a FIDIC contracts expert, independent advisor, dispute adjudicator for the local and international projects, claims and variations management, taking part in a large scale project preparation and management schemes for local and international projects. He has as well participated to the translation of several FIDIC Contracts into the Hungarian language.

Each training session will include a brief summary of the major changes and differences between the 1999 and the 2017 FIDIC Contract Editions. At the end of both training days, participants will be invited to solve real-life case studies.
